

Clearing Leckhampton Hill

Two pictures from FOLK, Friends of Leckhampton Hill & Charlton Kings Common, showing a party recently cutting and clearing sidings on the hill. This is normally carried out once a year. FOLK has over 400 members, including a number of regular volunteers who work alongside Cheltenham Borough Council, the site's owner, to manage and promote the use of the Hill and Common. They have a strong influence on the management, use and future of the site.
