We were recently contacted by the owner of Rock Mill House, a short way from Salmons Springs near Stroud, along the road towards Painswick. He is trying to find any photographs or plans of the mill itself. The mill had a succession of interesting uses over the centuries – part of the site housed the Rock Brewery at one time. However, it was largely demolished at the beginning of the 20th century. A surviving part was used initially as stabling, then later converted to a garage.
